**MINUTES** 

- 1. Welcome and opening remarks: The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. To consider and approve apologies for absence: these were approved.
- 3. To declare any conflicts and pecuniary interests on any items on this month's agenda: None declared
- **4.** To discuss the budget for 2026-2027: the draft budget started off in a deficit of £19K. Each line of the budget was discussed in detail.
- Cllr Judd was asked to leave the meeting room whilst pay rises where discussed for the Groundsman and the Cemetery Gardener. It was agreed to put both up to £17.50 per hour.
- It was agreed due to the lack of budget the war memorial fencing will not be renewed in this year's budget.
- It was agreed the topple test on the headstones at the cemetery needed doing.
- It was agreed for a pay increase to £15 per hour for the Cleaner and Hall Administrator.
- It was agreed to still have four editions of the Upwell Magazine per annum.
- It was noted to NOT have any more dog waste bins as Upwell has sixteen already.
- It was agreed not to give a grant to Three Holes village hall a £5K.

6. Close: the meeting closed at 20.48pm

- Due to the tightness of the budget Groundsman, Cemetery Gardener, Cleaner, and Village Administrator pay increases will start 1st April 2026.
- It was agreed the PRoW's will be cut as and when necessary, currently this has been cut on a rolling basis by the contractor.
- It was noted there is no monies in the budget for the riverbanks to be cut in this year's budget.
- **5. To agree the precept:** it was noted the precept had not been increase since 2022-23. It was agreed to increase the precept to £51K for 2026-27.
